Weather Expected for 15 days ahead

16th June 2 0 2 4 Issue

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- 1st Week (1st June-7th June)
- Extremely heavy to very heavy rainfall observed at isolated places over Meghalaya, Kerala and Mahe on 1st June; over Assam, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Odisha, Rayalaseema, Meghalaya, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana on 3rd June; over Sub-Himalaya West Bengal, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Karaikal on 4th and 5th June.
- Isolated heavy rainfall reported over Arunachal Pradesh on 01st June; Nagaland on 05th June; Manipur on 5th June; Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 01st & 05th June; Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 01st & 02nd June; Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim on 01st & 02nd June; Rayalaseema on 02nd June; Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal on 02nd ,03rd and 04th June; Chhattisgarh on 03rd June; South Interior Karnataka on 03rd & 04th June; North Interior Karnataka on 04th & 05th June; Coastal Karnataka on 04th June; Assam & Meghalaya on 05th June; Rayalaseema on 05th June; West Madhya Pradesh 05th June; Madhya Maharashtra on 05th June.
- Heat wave to severe heat wave conditions prevailed over Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh on all days during all dates in the week of 1st June to 05th June; over Punjab, West Rajasthan on all days from 1st June to 04th June; over East Rajasthan during 4th and 5th June; Himachal Pradesh during 2nd and 3rd June; East Madhya Pradesh on all days during the week from 1st June to 05th June except on 4th June;



West Madhya Pradesh on 1st June and 4th to 5th June; Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha and Vidarbha on 1st June.

Analysis of Weekly overall Rainfall distribution It shows for the country as a whole, the weekly cumulative All India Rainfall in % departure from its long period average (LPA) till week ending on 5 June was +8%. The specified information is shown in the table for past week over various regions of India and over India as a whole (Table 1).

2nd Week (8th June-15th June)

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall observed at isolated places over Konkan, Goa, Assam, Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Madhya Maharashtra and Coastal Karnataka on 8th June; over Sub Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Konkan, Goa, Coastal Karnataka and North Interior Karnataka on 9th June; at isolated places over Konkan, Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim on 10th June; over Konkan, Goa, Coastal Karnataka and on Tripura 11th June; observed at isolated places over Meghalaya and Sikkim on 12th June; over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Assam, Meghalaya, Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan, Goa, Gujarat region, Telangana, Kerala and Mahe on 13th June; observed at isolated places Assam, Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim on 14th and 15th June.
- **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry Karaikal, Interior Karnataka and Kerala and Mahe on 8th June; at isolated places over Assam Meghalaya, Marathwada, Madhya Maharashtra, Kerala, Mahe, Gujarat Region, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry , Karaikal, South Karnataka, Nagaland, Mizoram and Tripura on 9th June; at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Assam and Meghalaya on 10th June; at isolated places over Madhya Maharashtra, North Interior Karnataka, Telangana, Odisha, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam Meghalaya on 11th June; at isolated places over Assam, Konkan, Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, West Madhya Pradesh, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana on 12th June; at isolated places over Assam, Konkan, Goa,

Madhya Maharashtra, West Madhya Pradesh, North Interior Karnataka and Telangana on 14th June; at isolated places over Konkan, Goa, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Bihar on 15th June.

Heat Wave is observed over isolated pockets

of East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, north Madhya Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi, Bihar and Gujarat state on 8th June; over isolated pockets of Bihar, Gangetic West Bengal, East Uttar Pradesh, north Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Bihar, Gujarat and Jharkhand on 9th June; over some parts of Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, isolated pockets of Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Punjab, Haryana and Odisha on 10th June; over many parts of East Uttar Pradesh, West Uttar Pradesh, south Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttarakhand, north Rajasthan, Odisha and northeast Madhya Pradesh on 11th June; over isolated pockets of Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Bihar, Punjab, north Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal on 13th June; over most parts of East Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, North Odisha, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi on 15th June.

Weather Expected for 15 days ahead

4 1st Week

16th-22nd June Wind Speed:

- High wind speed may be expected over some parts of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar (Fig 1).
- Medium wind speed may be expected over some parts of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Odisha and West Bengal. (Fig 1)
- Low wind speed may be expected over North Eastern states, some parts of Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh. (Fig 1)




Figure No. 1 Wind Speed (m/s)

16th-22nd June Maximum Temperature

• **Temperature** in the range of **42.3-45.6 Deg.C** may be expected over Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, some parts of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh; **temperature** in the range **35-42.3 Deg.C** may be expected over some parts of Gujarat, Maharashtra, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, and West Bengal. 


Figure No. 2 Maximum Temperature Deg.C

16th-22nd June Rainfall

• Heavy Rainfall may be expected over north eastern states; moderate to rather heavy rainfall may be expected over some parts of Maharashtra, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and West Bengal. (Fig 3).

Light Rain - 2.5-7.5 mm

Moderate Rain-7.6-35.5 mm

Rather Heavy Rain-35.6-64.4 mm

Heavy Rain-64.5-124.4 mm

Very Heavy Rain-124.5-244.4 mm

Extremely heavy rain >244.5 mm




Figure No. 3 Rainfall (mm/day)

4 2nd Week

23rd-30th June Wind Speed

- High wind speed may be expected over some parts of Gujarat, Rajasthan, Punjab, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Uttar Pradesh.(Fig 4)
- Medium wind speed may be expected over some parts of Madhya Pradesh, Telangana, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Jharkhand. (Fig 4)
- Low wind speed may be expected over north eastern states, some parts of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, North Eastern States, Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh. (Fig 4)




Figure No. 4 Wind Speed (m/s)

23rd-30th June Maximum Temperature

• Temperature may remain in the range of 42-45°C over Punjab, Haryana, Delhi and Rajasthan; temperature may remain in the range 35-42°C over some parts of Gujarat, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh. (Fig No 5).




Figure No. 5 Maximum Temperature in Deg.C

23rd-29th June Rainfall

Rather heavy rainfall may be expected over North eastern states, some part of West Bengal,
Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Karnataka and Western Ghats of Maharashtra; Moderate rain may be
expected in some parts of Maharashtra, Karnataka, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh,
Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. (Fig 6).

Light Rain – 2.5-7.5 mm

Moderate Rain-7.6-35.5 mm

Rather Heavy Rain-35.6-64.4 mm

Heavy Rain-64.5-124.4 mm

Very Heavy Rain-124.5-244.4 mm

Extremely heavy rain >244.5 mm




Figure No. 6 Rainfall (mm/day)
